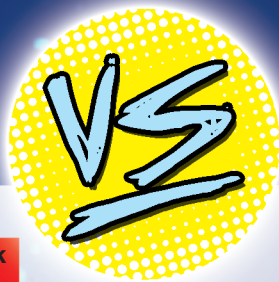

THE TEENAGE WITCH

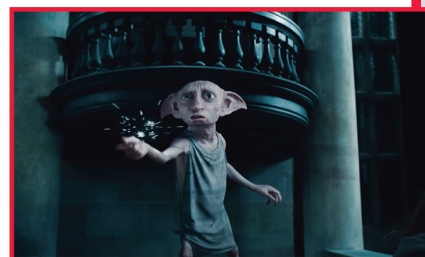

**Round 1 Winner: Sabrina totally gets the better deal.**

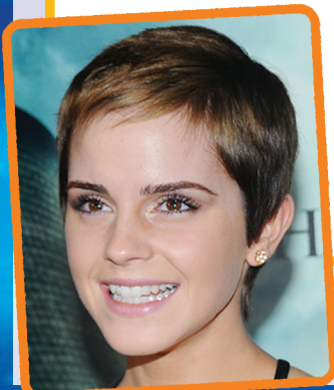

**Round 2 Winner: Sabrina. Can you argue with this evidence?**

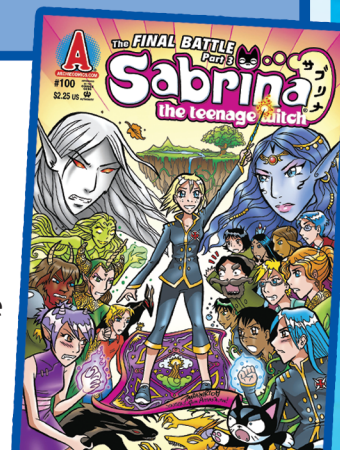
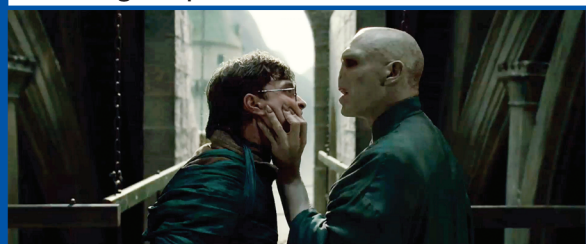


## Round 3: Mad Magic Skills
